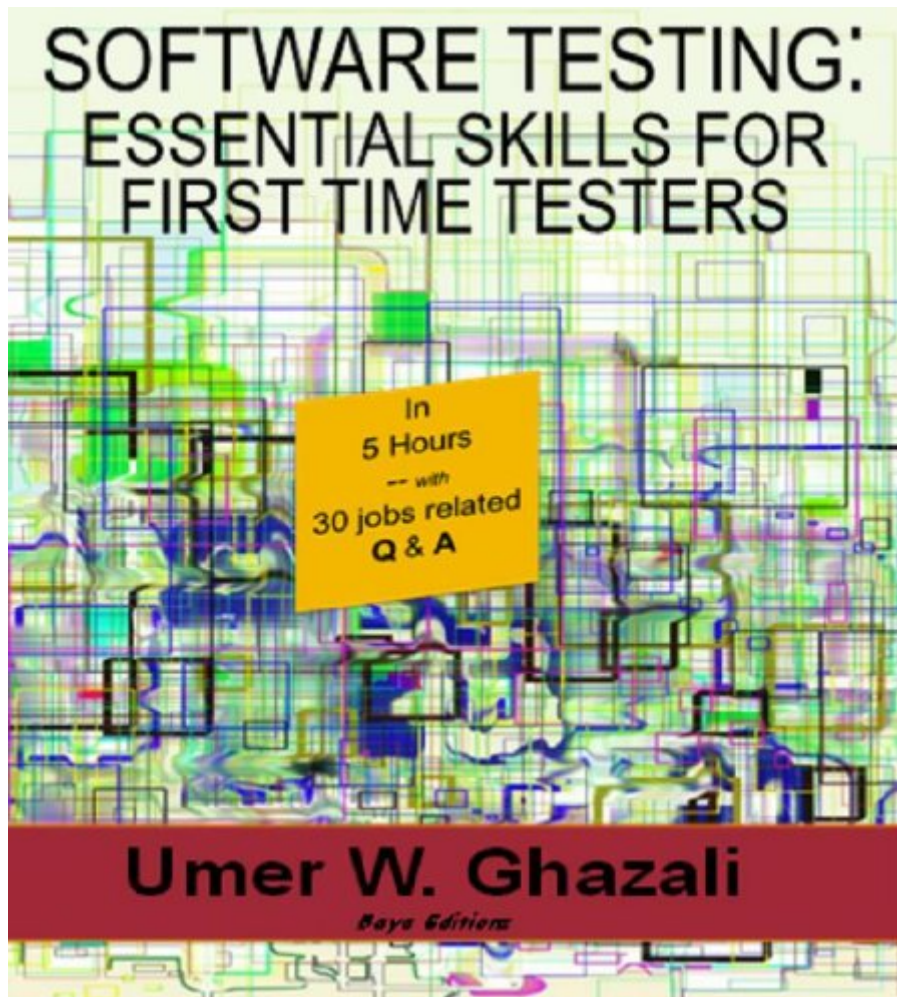

Very basic book, lacks detail and polish and I found very little applicable knowledge in it, besides the author seems to drag on about subjects and concepts that offer little value to a beginning tester eager to know about his/her trade, I would suggest instead Software Testing by Brian Hambling, it's more expensive but worth it.
